1 Cor 11:4-5: ⁴ Every man who prays or prophesies with his head covered dishonors his head. ⁵ But every woman who prays or prophesies with her head uncovered dishonors her head—it is the same as having her head shaved.


Ladies fashion in church is another divisive issue in the Corinthian church similar to being able to eat meat offered to idols.




Although Jesus created and sustained all things (Col 1:17-18), Jesus voluntarily submitted to the Father and did nothing outside of his will. (John 5:19)

¹⁹ Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does.

Submission doesn't mean less than. Jesus is not less than God simply because he chose to submit to the Father.

When we submit to our headship, we are under the blessings and coverings of that headship.



We will celebrate our communion (Common Union) together at the end, just a couple of points.

Jesus served Judas communion knowing full-well what was coming. Sin does not disqualify you from communion, therefore don't exclude yourself from this means of grace whenever it is offered to you.

You can have communion with your own family. Don't know what to say? Open your bible.

Isn't it interesting that the Corinthians were asking Paul about these Spiritual Gifts? They had already been experiencing them in their church, but they didn't fully understand or know how to use them.

These gifts all come from the same Spirit (God), they are not from separate pagan Gods as they were accustomed.

Wisdom, Knowledge, Faith, Healing, Miracles, Prophecies, Discernment, Tongues, Interpretation
